With interchangeable hydraulic reels, an 18-hp diesel engine, variable-reel speed control and three-wheel drive, operators can cut all types of grass, including early morning wet grass. Other features include an electric cold-start clutch and a transport speed of eight mph in the two-wheel-drive mode. Wide flotation tires and lightweight design provide reliable traction without a heavy footprint. The updated engine design routes exhaust below and behind the operator.

## Core Aerators

The CA-60 is a professional Category 1, three-point hitch aeration tool designed with independent dual-wheel coring heads that independently follow the ground contour. With its five-foot aerating width, the CA-60 is built for use on athletic fields, parks, golf courses, etc. The CA-34 is a pull-type unit with a coring width of 34 inches for use with small to medium-sized tractors or utility vehicles. For transport, the wheels lift into place by hand-operated levers. The company also manufactures spreaders, seeders, rollers and field groomers.

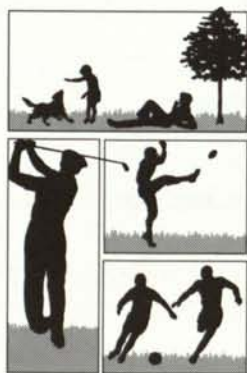

## Sprinkler Head Saver

The Power-Comb is a dethatcher that passes over underground sprinkler heads without causing damage. It's the same rugged machine as the Power-Thatch but is available with a "combing" shaft for new turf and more tender northern grass varieties. The shaft assemblies are interchangeable onto either machine housing. The Power-Comb shaft is flexible, with spring tines molded into a rubber mounting. The combination of rubber and high-carbon wire gives the tines an exceptional life span. Many safety features are standard.
